Exporting Bookmarks or Favorites from your Favorite Browser

You may have a different version of the browser than the one listed here. If so, there may be slight variations from these instructions.

Google Chrome - If you want your bookmarks to follow you. Make sure 'Sync' is turned on and 'Bookmarks' selected


1. Sign in to Google Chrome from a trusted computer.
2. At the top right, click the icon you see: Menu  or More .
3. Click **Settings**.
4. Under "Sign in," click Set up sync...
5. **Advanced sync settings**.
6. Choose the information you want to sync:
 - To sync all data, click the Down arrow  > **Sync everything**.
 - To choose what gets synced, click the Down arrow  > **Choose what to sync**. Then check the boxes you want. This is where you would select 'Bookmarks'.

It may take up to 24 hours to sync.

Internet Explorer – v 11

1. Click *File*
2. Select *Import and Export*
3. Select *Export to a file*
4. Select *Favorites*
5. Highlight *Favorites*
6. Browse to your home folder (H). Click Save
7. Click *Export*, and then click *Finish*.
8. The file you saved will be named *bookmark.htm*

Mozilla Firefox – v 46.0.1

1. Open Mozilla Firefox
2. Go to *Bookmarks*  and *Show All Bookmarks* to open the Library window
3. From the toolbar on the Library window, click *Import and Backup* and choose *Export Bookmarks to HTML...*
4. In the Export Bookmarks File window that opens, *choose your home folder (H:)* and click *Save*
5. Close the Library window
6. The file you saved will be named *bookmarks.html*
